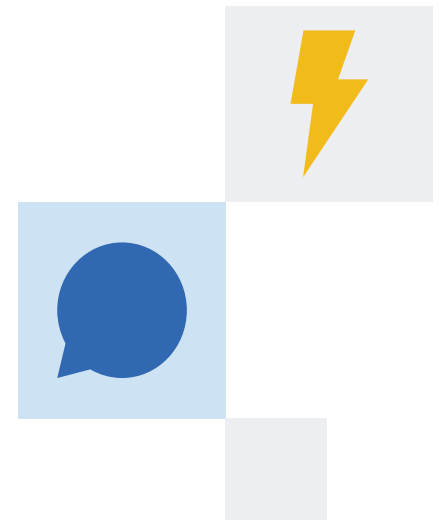


The Number Hunt
