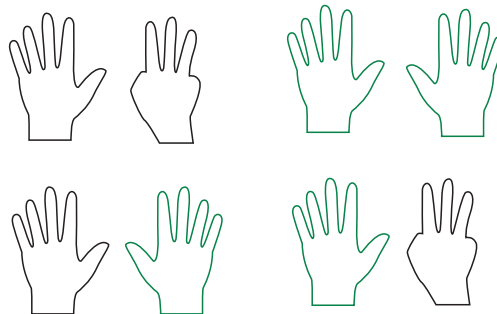

**Fingers Up for 10!**

**Directions:** Work with your student to add two numbers by making 10.

- Name two numbers from 5 to 10.
- Show one number with your fingers. Your student shows the other number. Make sure to use all of the fingers of one hand for the first 5 of each number.
- Add the two numbers by first making 10. Put your hand of 5 with your student's hand of 5 to make 10. Then, add the rest of the fingers and add it to 10.
- Repeat several times with different pairs of numbers from 5 to 10.



**Key Terms**

**number line**

A **number line** is a line that shows numbers marked at equal distances from each other.



**open number line**

An **open number line** is a blank number line on which you can write points or numbers that help you to solve problems.
