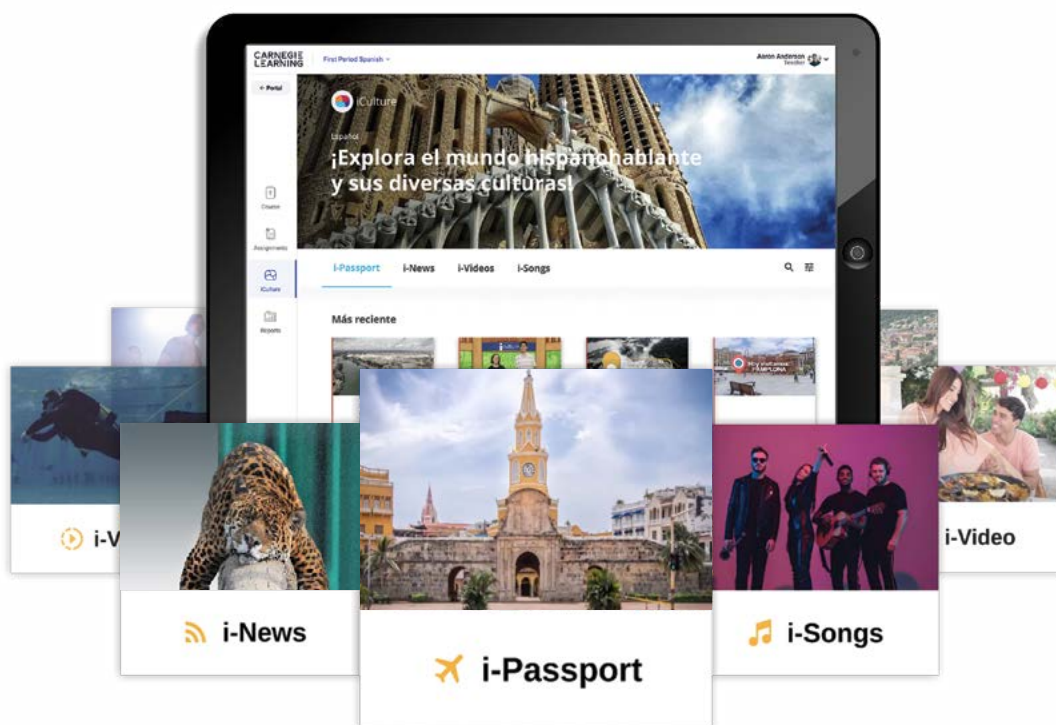

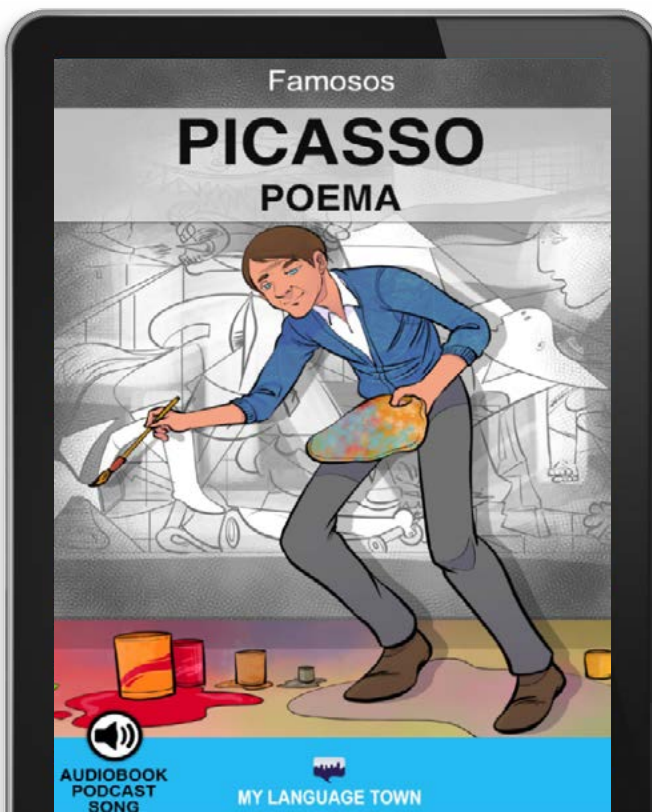

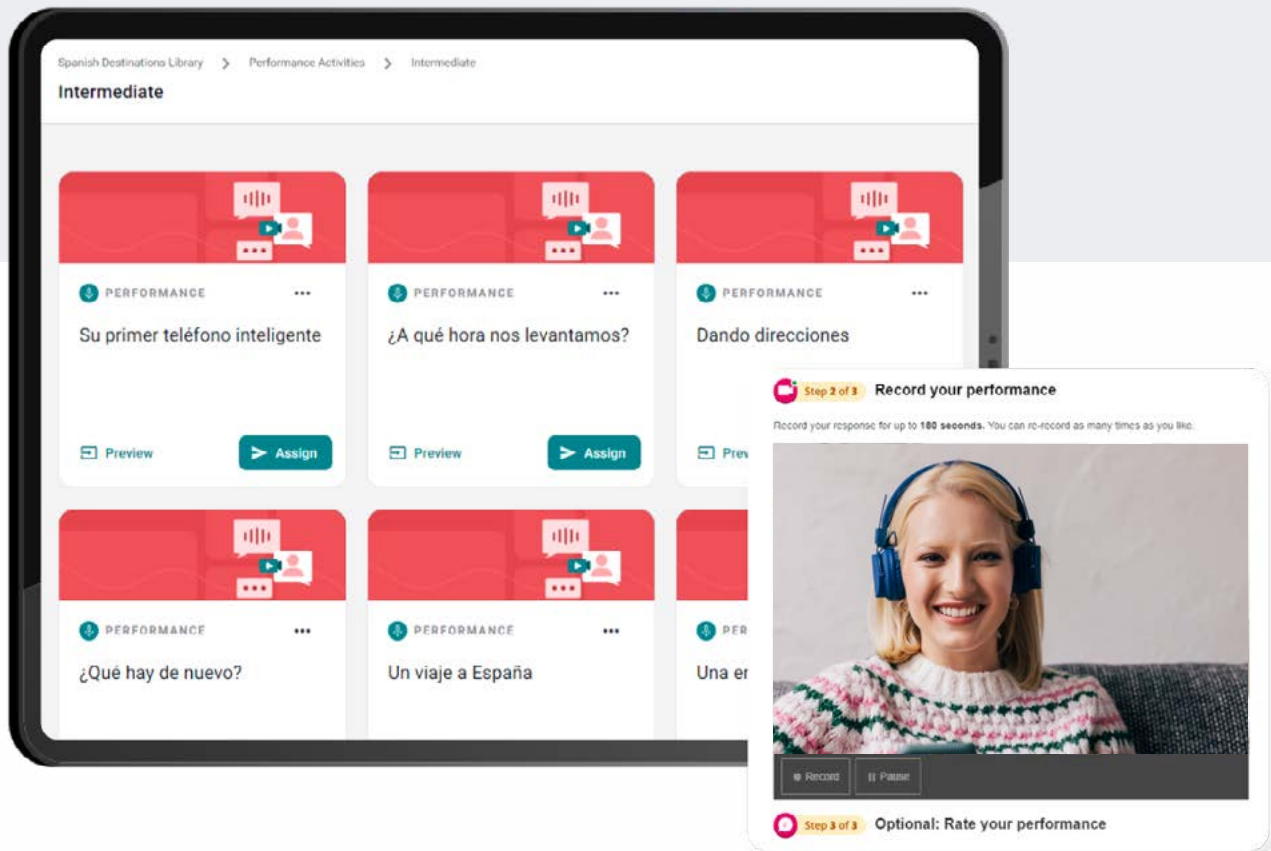

1. Ask students to read the **Pregunta clave** and speculate about the theme of the unit and the vocabulary and culture they might encounter.
2. **San Juan**, the Capital of Puerto Rico and its largest city, is located on the northern coast of the island, sharing colonial forts people visited to what is now known as **Viejo San Juan**. It is characterized by its narrow, cobblestoned streets and colonial buildings, many of which are now painted in bright colors.
3. Christopher Columbus arrived on the island in 1493 and named it **San Juan Bautista**; its main port was named **Ciudad de Puerto Rico**. Over time, people began to call the entire island **Puerto Rico** and to refer to the city as **San Juan**.
